- Shopping Centers/ Office Buildings - Greater of dues based on number of employees or \$0.0023 per square foot of gross leasable space.
- Government - Greater of \$175 or \$0.16 per capita of population.
- Apartments/ Trailer Parks - \$175 first 10 units; plus \$1.13 per each additional unit.

\* Employees means full-time; two part-time equal one full time.
