

2024-2025 Program Overview

Young Leaders is a program established by the Marion County Chamber of Commerce. This program runs parallel to Leadership Marion and gives students an opportunity for a deeper understanding of Marion County. Students will spend the year touring the community while learning about its strengths, challenges, and opportunities! Class members will be exposed to influential business leaders and young professionals from across Marion County and will have the chance to explore careers, ask questions of industry professionals, and discover the spirit of collaborations that make Marion County a great place to live, work, learn, and play.

Program goals:

- O To develop effective styles of leadership, communication, and decision-making skills.
- O To create an environment that nurtures potential young leaders to participate in school events, community service, and volunteerism.
- O Acquire a network of adult leaders in the community, who can provide mentorship for their success beyond high school.
- O To interact with peers, leaders, and decision makers from all segments of the community.
- O To meet students from Marion County that attend other high schools and to develop mutual trust and respect for each other.
- O Increase familiarity with area beyond their immediate neighborhood and schools.

Application Process

The application will be open and available for students to apply from March 18th-May 31st . The application can be accessed at www.marionchamber.com/young-leaders. **The application will require you to upload the Application Agreement with the signatures from the student, parent/guardian, and a designated school representative and a 1-2 minute video telling us about yourself and why you want to be in the program.** Students for the program will be selected and contacted by June 30th via e-mail.

Criteria:

- O 2.5 GPA or higher
- O Current high school freshmen will apply and be eligible for their sophomore year.
- O Be approved by the high school Principal, Counselor, or Graduation Coach
- O Commit to full participation of the program.
